

In this 4th Sunday in Advent, we light the candle for Love.



#### \*\*New\*\* O Antiphons of Advent 17th-23rd December

The "O Antiphons" are the antiphons preceding the Magnificat read at Vespers (Evening Prayer) and are said for seven days in preparation for the celebration of Christ's nativity: Based on Isaiah's prophecies, they reveal the different titles given to the expected Messiah. Each begins with the exclamation "O" and ends with a plea for the Messiah to come. As Christmas approaches the cry becomes increasingly urgent. O Sapientia (O Wisdom) *Isaiah* 11:2–3; 28:29 O Adonai (O Lord) *Isaiah* 11:4–5; 33:22; O Radix Jesse (O Root of Jesse) *Isaiah* 1:1; 11:10; O Clavis David (O Key of David) *Isaiah* 9:6; 22:22; O Oriens (O Rising Sun) *Isaiah* 9:1; O Rex Gentium (O King of the Nations) *Isaiah* 9:5; 2:4; O Emmanuel (God with us) *Isaiah* 7:14. When read backwards, the first letter of Sapientia, Adonai, Radix, Clavis, Oriens, Rex, and Emmanuel form the Latin words: ERO CRAS. These can be understood as the words of Christ, responding to his people's plea, "Tomorrow I will be there."

## \*\*New\*\* Cashless Card Machine in St Benedict's

Please note that there is now a cashless card machine in St Benedict's Church which is very simple to use. Using the Tablet touch screen, select which category you wish to donate to; 2. Select the amount you wish to give (or you have the option to "choose your own amount"); 3. Once the Donate button is selected, the white Sum Up box screen will indicate that you can make a contactless payment with your Credit/Debit card or Smart Device; 5. If your donation qualifies for Gift Aid, a new screen appears asking you if you want to fill out the Gift Aid info now or later (if you choose later you will get an email). If you wish to give the Gift Aid info straightaway, type in your email address, select Add Gift Aid, and complete the additional information using the key pad shown on the screen. **This is only necessary on the first use of the credit or debit card.** We will be installing a cashless card machine in Our Lady's Church in the New Year.

## \*\*New\*\* Reminder regarding Holy Mass times in January

Please remember that from 4th January until 1st February 2026, there will no 6pm Holy Mass at Our Lady's Marnhull. 6pm Evening Mass will recommence on Sunday 8th February. There will be no weekday Masses from Wednesday 31st December until 9th February 2026.
