Colin will talk about Mandela, focussing particularly on forgiveness and reconciliation including an introduction to apartheid, and after his talk there will be an opportunity to ask questions through the Question and Answer facility. This event will be held via Zoom at 7pm on *Tuesday 8th June*. The evening should provide fascinating insights into Nelson Mandela and life on Robben Island and it would be wonderful if you would promote this event to your congregation and those you feel might be interested.
