Children's Mental Health Week

It's children's mental health week this week. The theme this year is 'Let's connect' - focused on the importance of making connections with others. On Friday we focussed on the importance of making connections. The children thought about one person who they are connected to, who they feel is good for their mental health - someone who makes them happy or cheers them up.
