

An average of 23 people attended the talks over the six weeks and a total of £380 was raised for Gillingham Food Bank. Our Lady's provided a soup lunch on three occasions, which was a big commitment, but one which was hugely appreciated. There was a real buzz when parishioners of the three churches arrived at Our Lady's for lunch and our little side chapel witnessed something very special indeed. In the concluding document of the Synod Pope Francis asks us to 'intensify the ecumenical journey with other Christian's', and I hope these short talks illustrate our commitment to put this into practice. Assisted suicide Bill even worse than before - please take a red & white card from the back of the Church

Committee Stage of the assisted suicide Bill has ended. It is now weaker and less safe than it was before. 300+ amendments that sought to strengthen safeguards in the Bill and protect vulnerable groups were rejected by Bill supporters, including protection for people with disabilities and domestic abuse victims.
