*Liturgy of the Word

There will be no 6pm Sunday Mass on 7th, 14th, & 28th January and therefore there will be a celebration of the Liturgy of the Word in lieu: The obligation associated with Sundays and holidays is an obligation for Catholics to take part in the celebration of the Mass and not an obligation to receive communion (except once a year). On those occasions when a priest is not available to celebrate every regular Sunday Mass, we are obliged to try to attend one of the other regular Masses that are being celebrated that day in the parish or in a neighbouring parish. When, for personal circumstances, the obligation to attend Mass cannot be met, the faithful are strongly encouraged to attend church at the usual time to take part in a Liturgy of the Word. This will involve praying the prayers of the day, listening to the scripture readings, and usually a homily, making a profession of faith and praying the Prayers of the Faithful (Bidding Prayers). This will usually be led by a deacon and will not involve receiving Holy Communion.

Hospital Stays

f you have a stay in hospital and would like a priest to visit you, it is worth making a point of saying so to the nurse who admits you or getting someone to tell the Catholic Chaplain. Otherwise data protection rules may prevent the word getting through. Also, let the parish priest know, and try to make sure your records are up-to-date as far as your religion is concerned; apparently such records are not infrequently out of date or erroneous. This can of course be another reason why a priest wouldn't be aware that you were in hospital.
