At their meeting last Thursday, the Historic Churches Commission approved our proposal to install a new sound system in Our Lady's. We have to wait for formal notification before proceeding, but it shouldn't be too long before we enjoy its benefits. The novel technology promises to give a better quality of sound throughout the building without feedback. The sound is produced by 'sound panels' which are small panels which will be flush with the walls and can be painted the same colour so there is minimal visual impact. We will just need two panels in the Nave and one in the Chapel Room to give complete coverage. Digital hearing aids will pick up the sound automatically.
