Please spare a thought and a prayer for the inmates of Guy's Marsh prison. Due to a shortage of staff, the prisoners are currently being locked in their cells most of the time. They are not even allowed to leave their wing to attend Holy Mass in the chaplaincy, and at this stage there is no guarantee that they will even be allowed to do so for Christmas. You'll understand that this is already a very stressful time of year in the prison. Restriction on movement will only make the prisoners more frustrated, so the staff who remain will face a very challenging time as well. The rumour is that the situation will not change until February. Fr. Francis will go to the prison on Mondays as usual and will say Mass with the chaplaincy team in attendance, praying for the prisoners who cannot be there; bringing Jesus Christ as close to them as he can.

# Open Church event at St. Benedict's to Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> January

This will involve inviting all and sundry to join them, votive candles, prayer support and generous listening. They are asking for volunteers to help with supervising candles, helping to write prayers, continuous prayer, controlling music and being warm and welcoming. They ask you to meet them at 2.15 p.m. for prayers and preparation. The plan is to finish at about 4 p.m. depending on what happens. They ask you to encourage friends and family of whatever persuasion to come along after 3 p.m. Please contact Tony Moore, Annette Lyons or Deacons Mike or James to offer help.

The Diocese has now informed us of the mandatory Second Collections for 2023. These are listed below together with a few which are particular to this parish:

- On Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> January there will be a second collection as indicated. This is because Churches Together in Marnhull and the Gillingham Community Church are setting up warm spaces for those who lack heating to use a few times during the week. We are asked to contribute to the cost of heating for these venues.
- Each parish is asked to have an annual appeal by a religious order which works in mission lands. Ours will take place on 19<sup>th</sup> February; a priest from the Columban Missionary Society will say all the Masses on that day.
- Because of this parish's connection with Guy's Marsh Prison, I invite you to contribute to the second collection on 1<sup>st</sup> October for PACT, the Catholic charity which does so much to help prisoners to turn away from crime and their families to cope with the consequences of their relative's imprisonment.
